GENERAL RULES OF MEETING

- The meeting is held under the ACU National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU and these Supplementary Regulations.
- All riders must be members of SCRMC, day membership available.
- Any withdrawal of entry must be submitted in writing. Any refunds will be at the discretion of the SCRMC Scrambles Committee.
- All entry forms must be completed in full and sent with payment & appropriate forms as necessary.
- ILLEGAL RIDING AT MEETINGS - Anyone riding on the track out-with races or misbehaving in the pits will be banned from the meeting.
- Scrutineering & Signing on will take place on Fri 14th July between 18;00 & 19;00 and Sat 15th July between 08;00 & 09;00
- Practice will be from 09;00 to 10;15 and will be per class
- Duration of races will be as per programme
- Bikes may be ridden, at walking pace only, along riding lane to start/finish, any rider flouting the above rule will be banned from the meeting.
- Riders must hold a current Off Road Competition License issued by the SACU, ACU, IOPD, MCF, AMCA and any foreign FIM affiliated federation with start permission. One Event Licenses will be available (available to download at www.classicscramble.com & www.sacu.co.uk)
- IOPD, AMCA & MCF Licence holders are required to pay an insurance supplement of £5 and complete a SACU Medical Declaration Form (download at www.classicscramble.com)
- All riders MUST have a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher available.
- All Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- SCRMC retain the right to alter or amend the programme at their discretion.
- I undertake to notify the club of any recent [within the last 23 days] concussion injury and will produce a doctor's note to state I am able to compete in the event. The doctor's note to state "The rider is no longer suffering the consequences of concussion"
- **Transponders will be used at this meeting and riders will be supplied (at extra cost) if they do not have a personal one**
